


# Strictly Robots

This game is to help your child understand words we use to talk about the order we do things in,

e.g. 'First touch your toes then clap your hands three times'.

To play this game you will need the feedback cards attached. These will give the 'robot' feedback on how well he or she completed the instructions.

- i.e. Smiley face - all correct
- Sad face - made lots of mistakes
- Thoughtful face - made just one mistake, try again



Let your child be the robot. Give him or her instructions to follow using the words: before, after, first, last, above, below, behind, once, twice...

Start by asking your child to complete two-part instructions, e.g. 'before you take two steps forward clap your hands above your head'. When he or she has completed both parts, use the feedback cards to give them feedback. Once your child can do this you can introduce three-part instructions.

## Variations

To make this game easier keep the instructions short.

To make this game harder use longer instructions.
