## Like / Don't Like Cards



This game is to help your child understand and use 'but not' statements.

e.g. 'I like peas but not carrots'

You will need the 'like / don't like' pictures and faces to play this game. Cut them out and make sure your child knows what they are before you start the game. Place the two faces on the table or floor. Tell your child that the happy face is for the things he or she likes and the sad face is for things he or she doesn't like.

Next place the small cut out pictures in a pile in front of your child face down. Take turns at choosing two pictures and saying what you like and don't like using 'but not' statements,

e.g. 'I like the rainbow but not the peas'

You may need to remind your child to say 'but not' when he or she dislikes a picture.

## Variations:

To make this game easier use objects from your home that your child likes and dislikes.

To make this game harder do not use pictures but think of things you both like and dislike or ask your child to tell you why they don't like a picture.
