

Yes / No Game

This game is to help your child name things in groups. This is an important skill for vocabulary building.

To play this game you will need the 'yes / no category cards' attached and a 'yes / no board'.

Cut out the cards and place them in a pile face down. The first player is chosen to be the 'speaker'. He or she takes a picture and, without showing or telling the rest of the players, decides on the category it belongs to. The first player keeps this card throughout the game. The next player takes a card and shows it to the first player, who then says 'yes' or 'no' depending on whether it belongs to the category or not.

The card is then placed face up under the tick or cross as appropriate.

The aim of this game is to guess the category. When someone guesses the category the role of 'speaker' passes to that player, and a new card is chosen.




Variations

To make this game easier identify the category for the child to use.

To make this game harder encourage the child to think of sub-categories, e.g. water sports or hot weather clothes.


