



What's the time Mr Wolf

This game is to help your child learn 'when' questions and understand simple reasoning i.e. working out an answer.

You will need the 'when do we use' cards attached to play this game. You will also need some pieces of paper to act as stepping stones. Place the stepping stones out across the floor. Explain to your child that he or she has to try to get across a river before the wolf catches them. He or she can move onto the next stepping stone each time he or she can answer a 'when' question.

Ask your child the 'when' questions from the 'when do we' cards. If your child can give you a good answer then he or she can move onto the next stepping stone.

Make sure your child answers the 'when' question and does not say a place or an action for the answer,

e.g. adult: 'When do you use a swimming costume?'
 child: 'At the swimming pool.'
 adult: 'That is where we go swimming. We use a swimming costume when we go for a swim.'

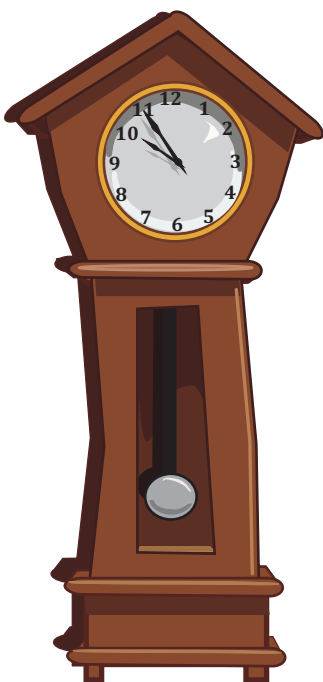
Variations:

To make this game easier give your child options for the answers.

e.g. 'When do we use an umbrella? When it's raining or when it's sunny?'

To make this game harder use more stepping stones and ask your child the 'when do we' questions,

e.g. 'When do we eat breakfast?'
 'When do we blow up balloons?'
 'When do we read a story?'
