
Turn Over



This game is to help your child understand words we use when placing conditions on instructions,



e.g. 'Get a drink unless you had one before.'

'You can wear any socks except the spotty ones.'

'Dad will be happy but not if you're still up.'

These are very complex words to learn. This game will help your child practise working out the meaning of these conditional words.

To play this game you will need a set of instruction cards and a set of shape cards.

Cut out the shape cards and place them all on the table face up. Place the instruction cards in a pile face down. Each player takes a turn to take an instruction card and follow the instructions turning over the shapes as directed. If the instruction cannot be completed the turn passes to the next player. The winner is the player who manages to turn the last card over.

You may have to explain to your child what each of the conditional words mean,

e.g. 'Turn over all the triangles except the yellow one.' 'That means you need to turn over the blue triangle and the green triangle and leave the yellow triangle where it is.'

Variations


To make this game easier use fewer shape cards.

To make this game harder make up your own instructions adding in two conditions, e.g. 'Turn over the yellow triangle unless there is another triangle or a blue square'.
